An introduction to Denplan plans


At **Holly Tree House Dental**, we have many options for our patients to pay for their dental treatment. If you would like to spread the cost of your treatment at the practice, we have monthly payment plans from Denplan to help with this.

What is a dental payment plan?

A payment plan allows patients to spread the cost of their routine private dentistry without worrying about large, unexpected treatment costs. It allows patients to budget for their dental care and has additional benefits such as discounts and optional supplementary insurance.

At the practice, we offer the below payment plans for you to choose from:

- **Membership A**
(2 examinations and 2 hygienist appointments per year)
- **Membership B**
(2 examinations and 4 hygienist appointments per year)



Denplan Membership

Denplan Membership is an easy set-up maintenance plan. You pay a monthly fee that covers a set number of treatments, including dental check-ups, dental hygiene visits and dental x-rays. You can sign up quickly and easily even if you have outstanding treatment.

Why choose Denplan Membership?

- Encourages you to attend regular dental visits
- Allows for you to budget for routine oral care
- Simple to set up and discounts on any restorative treatment required

What does Denplan Membership include?

- Dental check-ups (frequency decided by your Dentist)
- Dental hygiene visits (frequency decided by your Dentist)
- Dental x-rays (The average person has 1 x-ray per year)
- Preventive dental advice and therapy

What's not included with Denplan Membership?

- Restorative dental treatments. (Such as fillings, crowns, bridges or dentures, lab fees and prescriptions)
- Any treatments your Dentist has excluded from your plan contract
- Referral to a specialist and specialist treatment
- Orthodontics, implants and cosmetic treatment
- Sedation fees
- Treatment carried out elsewhere
- Extraction of wisdom teeth

Denplan Supplementary Insurance

Denplan Supplementary Insurance is included in your Denplan payment plan, giving you worldwide dental injury and dental emergency cover. The insurance also includes a 24-hour worldwide dental emergency helpline.

Why choose Denplan Supplementary Insurance?

- Protects your oral health even when you're away
- You can claim up to £450 per incident for emergency treatment. Up to a maximum of £900 per claiming year
- You can access Denplan's 24-hour worldwide dental emergency helpline when your practice is closed
- Making a claim won't affect the cost of your insurance
- Terms, conditions and other exclusions may apply

What's included with Denplan Supplementary Insurance?

- You can claim up to £450 for temporary emergency treatment in the UK, when you're more than 40 miles from your registered dental practice
- You can claim up to £470 for temporary emergency treatment abroad
- You can claim cover towards treatment costs for a dental injury
- Mouth cancer cover
- Access to a 24-hour worldwide dental emergency helpline

What's not included with Denplan Supplementary Insurance?

- Treatment when you are within 40 miles of your dental practice
- Routine dental treatment
- Dental injury treatment more than 18 months after the date of the injury
- Terms, conditions and other exclusions may apply





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
